Responsibilities & Accountabilities

- Daily inspections of vans including completing proper documentation
- Pick up and drop off guests each morning and afternoon at the Day Base location
- Assisting in pick-up of guests that are leaving the field early due to fatigue or injury and assisting all injured guests once they are out of the field
- Assisting in welcome guests and initial guest training
- Assisting in set up of client's ski/board demos each morning
- Pick up/drop off lunches each morning from EPL. This includes insuring all cabrios, and water bottles are returned each night
- Relaying information to Day Base Manager of any broken gear or equipment



- Accounting for all beacons, radios, and water bottles from guests at the end of the day
- Shovel and sweep entry ways
- Thoroughly cleaning of van each day
- General cleaning and tidying of Day Ski Base
- Follow all company safety and security procedures
- Report any maintenance issues, damage, or safety hazards to management
